Jahn Grouts are vapor-permeable materials that are compatible with the substrate that is being restored, allowing water-soluble salts and other destructive minerals to be released from the masonry rather than remain trapped, causing deterioration.

Jahn Injection Grouts are single-component grouts that are easy to mix correctly. There are no chemicals to add in the field, which protects against product variation and helps ensure quality control. They are easier to apply than epoxies, due to their low viscosity. Deep, thorough penetration can be achieved with minimal pressure, and they can be applied by pouring or pumping. Clean-up is easy too. A water-based formula means no solvent is needed for clean-up and no disposal hassles.

You can choose between M30 Injection Grout (for hairline cracks up to 3/16" wide) and M40 Crack Injection Grout (for cracks 1/4" and larger). We offer multiple formulations, and we can adjust the grout in our laboratory to match the properties of the substrate being repaired.
